

TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN


The Telangana Government runs 326 Ashram Schools, 183 Gurukulam residential schools and 1432 primary schools in different tribal habitations, for Tribal children to benefit from education, nutrition support and peer interactions which shape young minds towards future goals. These Schools cater primarily to children from Tribal communities, without isolating them from their area, often bridging gaps between limited household incomes and available local Institutions.

We invest in education as a tool to enable children to realize their potential. But education alone is not adequate. Children require a safe environment to grow in.

We need to create awareness through Safety clubs, Teacher Counsellors and accurate content. I must appreciate the efforts of the Sahas Foundation in this regard. They have partnered with the Tribal Welfare Department, designing and sharing content for children, which we are placing in all our Institutions.

“Safety Skills” introduces children and their care-givers to the subject of child safety in a simple and engaging format. The safety workshop and Teacher training kits are also important tools for our Teachers and staff.

Together, we can ensure a healthy and safe environment for our children to grow in knowledge, character and confidence.
