Sharing a few noteworthy projects here.


Our Safety club Angel Sangeeta Giri traveled to remote parts of Karnataka and trained 1,600 + little children and teachers on good touch bad touch in 40+ small remote villages across Haliyal, Alnavar, Dharwad areas.



The Telangana government runs 326 Ashram schools, 183 Gurukulam residential schools, and 1432 primary schools in different tribal habitations. We received a letter of recommendation from Dr. Christina Chongthu, Secretary to Government, Tribal Welfare Department for empowering their teachers and staff with safety training and teacher training kits that they will use to empower children at their schools.



We mapped out school & Student data in Kerala and shared a proposal with the Kerala Government to empower children in Kerala with safety skills.



- We shared a proposal with the CBSE board to empower children under their educational board.
- We organized a digital workshop at Focus high school, Hyderabad.
